Inspection/Weigh-In:

• A referee, and when possible a physician (MD, DO, PA or NP) with experience in skin conditions (dermatologist, for example), shall inspect contestants BEFORE they are allowed to weigh-in. After entering the weigh-in area, wrestlers remain in the weigh-in area until they have completed the weigh-in. A minimum of two scales shall be used to conduct the weigh-in. The weigh-in shall be up to one hour in length. The actual weight of each contestant shall be recorded on the weigh-in form. The order of weight classes at weigh-in shall follow the order of weight classes to be wrestled at that tournament. All wrestlers weighing in at the same weight class must use the same scale. Weigh-ins will take place on site and will follow NFHS procedures: Wrestlers shall weigh-in wearing a legal uniform with suitable undergarments. Socks may be worn but may not be taken off as a means of making weight.

Format:

• The tournament format will be run on 2 mats with double elimination 16 man brackets with wrestlebacks to 3rd. Prelims will be utilized if necessary.

Finals:

• We will line up wrestlers for introductions immediately after the semi-final and consolation semi-final rounds have completed. We will wait until both matches in the weight class have completed before moving to the next weight class.

<u>Awards</u>:

Medals for first place and certificates for the Top 3.
